## BIOGRAPHY

With more than thirty five years of clinical experience of working with children with kidney disease I am one of the most senior and experienced paediatricians and paediatric nephrologists, nationally and internationally. Having been appointed as a Consultant in 1983 I was responsible for establishing the Paediatric Nephrology Department at The Royal Free Hospital and for developing the first renal transplant programme in North London for children over the age of five years. Within three years I had established a dialysis and renal transplant programme for children aged between one and five years old at Great Ormond Street Hospital (GOSH). Subsequently, for logistic reasons the two units were sited together at GOSH and the largest centre for dialysis and renal transplantation for children in the United Kingdom was opened in 1986.

As lead clinician in nephrology for ten years between 1990 and 2000, I witnessed the reputation of the renal unit at GOSH grow to become one of the largest and most active departments for treating children of all ages and with all types of renal disease in Europe and North America. In the past twenty five years more than 650 children have had successful renal transplants. The overall success rate has been improving dramatically over this time with patient survival almost 100 percent and graft survival improving with each decade reflecting the better medical care given to children and growing experience with modern immunosuppression. I have been the principal investigator at GOSH for three major international randomised clinical trials of immunosuppression in children receiving renal transplants. These trials are unique in the world literature.

Reflecting my interest for transplantation in children I have been an active member of the International Pediatric Transplant Association and am a Past President of this society dedicated to the care of children and their families who are in need of solid organ and bone marrow transplantation. It is a privilege to have been elected to this prestigious position by my colleagues.

My special interests within paediatric nephrology are not limited to transplantation. I have dedicated much time to the clinical and laboratory research of children with glomerular disease particularly nephrotic syndrome. I set up the only special out-patient clinic for children with this condition in the UK in order to study demography and epidemiology, and have recently received grant funding to establish a similar clinic for young adults. Working together with adult colleagues in nephrology will be an innovation. I am also the recipient of a major National Institute Of Health Research grant awarded to investigate the preferred induction treatment corticosteroid regimen for children presenting with nephrotic syndrome for the first time.

As a paediatrician my goal is to represent the interests of children and child health care and as a Past President of The Royal Society of Medicine, Section for Paediatric and Child Health and during my presidential year was responsible for organising a series of educational courses designed to engage with and update both general paediatricians and trainees.

Additional areas with which have been involved, include medical management and clinical ethics. I was Clinical Director of the medical unit at GOSH for ten years with responsibility for enlarging the number of specialities within the directorate. Similarly as Clinical Director of the International and Private Patient Directorate I was involved with the planning for the new Private Patient wing at GOSH and the need to offer child care services to a much wider community both within the UK and overseas.

As Chairman of one of the first UK Clinical Ethics Committees I was able to promote the subject to a wide medical and non-medical audience. As result a Department of Clinical Ethics has been established at GOSH. I have served as a trustee of the UK Clinical Ethics Network and have been a member of the Ethics Committee of The British Transplantation Society and The European Renal Association. Currently I am a member of the Ethics Committee of the Transplantation Society.

My extensive clinical practice and peer reviewed publications reflect my experience in caring for infants and children with congenital, hereditary and acquired renal disease. I have published in excess of 100 original peer reviewed contributions, book chapters and reviews. I teach and lecture regularly to post graduate students in the UK and overseas. I lecture overseas regularly and am a visiting paediatric nephrologist to many institutions.

In 2010 I received funding in order to establish a Transition Clinic for 16 – 25 year old patients who suffer with nephrotic syndrome. This specialist clinic for young people is the first of its kind in the UK and is based in the UCL Centre for Nephrology, Royal Free Hospital Campus.

I continue to have an active paediatric clinical practice in the UK and work closely with colleagues in paediatric urology, transplant surgery, radiology and histopathology reflecting the diverse nature of the speciality and the need to have the close support of key clinicians and laboratory based specialities.
